Overview: Research assistant for hoarding disorder investigation.

Specific activities include, but are not limited to:

This project will explore different aspects of hoarding disorder. Captured under this umbrella of concern are the impact on first responders (fire department, paramedics), clinical reflections and experience (including challenges related to providing assistance), and administrative bodies (health authorities, clinics). Of primary importance, the experience of those dealing with hoarding disorder will be addressed in full during year two of this research initiative (attention to stigma, lack of support services).

The primary job duties for the field research assistant will include conducting a thorough literature review and assisting in a publication review. Other duties may include conference poster presentations and workshop participation.

The successful candidate will work with, and directly report to, Dr. Murray Anderson at Athabasca University. Dr. Anderson will provide adequate training for the literature review requirements and publication review that will be required.

Qualifications:

The position is based out of Athabasca, Alberta. However, the majority of initial research duties can occur online.
